### *Language House Rules*

1. Follow all Residence Life rules of Alfred University, and all local, state, and federal laws.
2. Live cooperatively with other residents, acting whenever possible with kindness, respect, and compromise.
3. Agree not to disrupt classes, meetings or activities held in the house or on house property.
4. Complete house responsibilities and chores satisfactorily.
5. Actively participate in house and organization programs and activities.
6. Agree not to smoke in or near (within 200 feet) the house and ensure that any guests you have do not smoke in or near the house.
7. No pets allowed.
8. Speak in French. Learn about the diversity of French-speaking cultures.



All applications to live in the *Language House* will be reviewed by current residents, the house advisor for the period in question, and Dr. Bouhet (or other designated faculty members).

Approval will be based on the student’s application (including an interview if necessary), as well as the following minimum criteria:

1. The applicant must be an Alfred University student in good academic standing.
2. The applicant must demonstrate a willingness to live cooperatively and to make an effort to live in a *French-speaking immersion environment*.

The application process prioritizes acceptance of French majors and minors. Current residents must re-apply each year. Current resident’s accomplishments and performance while in the house will be anonymously peer reviewed by the other current house residents, and then by the house advisor and designated faculty members to determine their continued eligibility for occupancy.
